#164 - Handi Quilter Workshop - Meredyth Rothlisberger - This 3-Day workshop will get you on your way to using & enjoying longarm quilting, whether you own a Handi Quilter or another type of longarm machine - or you may be considering buying one! If you buy a Hand Quilter during this workshop, your registration will be applied to the purchase of your new machine. If you are renting our machine, this also is the perfect workshop for you. Here is partial listing of the workshop topics.

Basic Handi Quilter Class - Learn longarm basics, such as machine maintenance, threads, tensions, loading quilts, and pattern applications in order for quilters who own, want to rent or purchase a machine. **Three "B's"** - Backgrounds, Borders and Blocks that can be used on any project. You'll be shown a variety of designs that are suitable for use in backgrounds, blocks and borders. Learn how to draw your pattern before quilting so that it is in your memory. You'll also learn how to use stars, hearts and loops as a background fill. **Freehand Continuous Line** - learn the value of drawing freehand continuous line designs and that muscle memory is important to successfully apply the designs to the quilt. **Groovy Boards** - Learn how to place and use groovy boards. Differences and similarities between groovy boards and pantographs will be discussed. **Pantographs** - Discuss the tips and tricks of edge to edge Pantographs, how to complete a continuous border. Learn the differences and similarities between pantographs and groovy boards.
